Albany, Caversham & Clarkson:

Delivering Certificates I, II & III in General Education for young people in years 10, 11 & 12.

Midland: Delivering Australian Curriculum Framework for young people in years 8 & 9 and Certificate I, II & III in General Education for young people in years 10, 11 & 12.

Delivery: Self-paced on campus, 5 days a week or as required.

COURSES & DELIVERY

Certificate I, II & III in General Education for Adults (CGEA) in conjunction with Certificate II in Civil Construction and/or Resource and Infrastructure Work Preparation and short courses as needed (First Aid, WHS, driving lessons).

Year 11 students: 2-year course, CGEA 4 days a week and Civil Construction or Resource and Infrastructure 1 day. Year 12 students: 1-year course, CGEA 3 days a week and Civil Construction or Resource and Infrastructure 2 days.
